ORDER

Defendant Julia Beatrice Keleher's "EX-PARTE MOTION FOR LIMITED RELIEF FROM GAG [sic] ORDER" (Docket No. 43) is **NOTED**.

The protective order only enjoins defendant Keleher "from divulging, talking to, or discussing with the press, media and public . . . any information other than that entered without restriction on the docket or disclosed in open court, relating to the facts of the captioned case:" (Docket No. 13.) Its scope does not extend to statements made by Ms. Keleher during an administrative proceeding, or private conversations between Ms. Keleher and her "friends and loved ones."

Accordingly, it is clarified that Ms. Keleher may make statements in an administrative hearing, and that Ms. Keleher may have private conversations with her "friends and loved ones," unless those "friends and loved ones" are used as conduits to make

statements to the press, media, and the public, all of which are covered by the protective order.
